## **Regular Business:**

- Approval of Minutes Approved as written
- Principal's Report Steven Cotton
  - Offetting ready for school to start. Main hallway, 1959 hallway had a remodel. Removed all old lockers in the classroom and installed new ones. took out the old, leaky sinks and are in the process of installing new storage. Storage won't be ready by the start of school but will be ready to go shortly after school starts. We will continue to update our building.
  - Last summer we did the driveway to improve drop-off and pick-up
  - Student enrollment is just under 660 kids, a little lower than last year. Kindergarten enrollment is lower across the district.
    - New this year is the kindergarten screening process. It's a pre-k early elementary screening that all incoming kindergarteners will do. Families will be notified on 8/25 on who their student/s will have as a teacher. Staggered start date will be 8/29 & 8/31 for some and 8/30 & 9/1 for others. First year for this kindergarten process!
  - o 2 new teachers this year: Miss Amy Showers 2nd grade and Katherine Locke 3rd grade
  - Friday e-news will have information for drop-off and pick-up procedures. Exercise patience as the new school year begins. If you have any safety concerns or suggestions for these procedures, please call me or send me an email.

## • 2023/2024 PTA meetings

## • Open committee positions

- We are in need of LOTS of volunteers. We already have a great group of volunteers but we need many more to fill open committees and help with other committees. We are looking for both committee chairs and co-chairs and also volunteers to help.
- Current openings/need for volunteers (a list is attached). Below are the two big events we are looking for multiple chairs for:
  - Reflections This event takes place in the fall and it celebrates the arts such as dance, art writing, etc. The national PTA website has guidelines to follow and the tools you need to run a successful event. You would need to get the word out and collect the projects to be judged. You will need to publicize the event. Talk to classrooms. Mr. Cotton would like to help out and work with this committee. He'd like to see Pleasant View have the most kids up on stage in January at the ceremony. Classroom teachers will be willing to help pass the information along to families. The theme this year is "I am hopeful because...."
  - Variety Show The Variety Show is a big committee! We are the only school in the district that does not have a variety show. We used to but we do not have the volunteers to run the event. It is a lot of work but so rewarding. It was brought up to have high school students help out and earn their hours. Yes this could be a possibility but we would still need the adult volunteers to be present and run it. Adults have to watch all of the shows, watch the time, and make sure everything is appropriate. Teachers sometimes do an act. The event is usually in January/February.
  - Yearbook and Book Fair- Susan Smith has done an excellent job with the yearbook for many, many years and organizing the book fairs. It is time for someone else to start shadowing her and be ready to take over when her children are out of Pleasant View.

    - We have 2 Donuts with Grownups events. Please have one adult per student at each event. Our events are well attended and we are limited on space.
