- Principal's Report Steven Cotton

- Treasurer's Report Erin Onions
 - November Book Fair brought in around \$1500.
 - We made payment to Ballet Quad Cities from Fall Fest funds.
 - The final payment was made to Small Town Pastry for the 6th grade fundraiser pies.
 - The milk payment was made from Donuts with a Grownup.
- President's Report Megan Barone
 - We have a proposal for the playground renovation for all elementary schools in the district. The District is looking at bids now. This should be a two phase project, with Pleasant View being completed during the first phase. The plan is to replace pea gravel with a solid rubber surface on both primary and intermediate playgrounds and adding ADA equipment. If approved, work would begin summer 2024. District is asking the PTA from each school to contribute. Possible Walk-a-thon goal this spring.

- Vice-President's Report Susan Smith and Karyn Green
 - The spring conference is set for the night of February 29th so the Book Fair will run February 28 March 6.
 - We are researching ways to spend Scholastic dollars Possible book vending machine. Scholastic does not offer the machine but does offer book sets to fill them. Outside source is www.bookvending.com. The machine runs from \$5000-\$6500. We would need to raise funds and look at maintenance as well as location within the school.
