- **Call to Order:** Michelle LeMoine called the meeting to order at 9:01.
- **Approval of Minutes:** Treva Menke January minutes available on PTA website. Minutes approved.
- **Principal's Report:** Steven Cotton  
Apologies for not attending January meeting. Mr. Cotton made a presentation to the school board/elementary principals regarding 6th grade numbers for 2018-19 school year. Next year only, PLV will have 3 5<sup>th</sup> grade sections and 5 6<sup>th</sup> grade sections with one 5<sup>th</sup> grade teacher moving to 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Any additional incoming 5<sup>th</sup> graders may have to attend another elementary to keep the class sizes at reasonable level at PLV. Superintendent will watch the numbers closely.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Lisa Goodin See February treasurer's report. Activities for the month were the coupon books (which we get roughly half of that amount), family movie night, and gifts to school (check for \$17,000 for grade level items and checks written to each teacher for \$100 for consumable items for their classroom).

Superintendent meeting: bid for Cody construction came in under \$400,000 budget. Groundbreaking to begin spring--proposed completion October 2018. Forest Grove bids will come in 2019.

PV Foundation—scholarships for PV grads. PLV PTA donates \$500 to this scholarship fund. 90 scholarships are given out to graduating seniors.
