- Variety Show: The Variety Show is coming back after being away for many years! The committee will be coming around to the classrooms to talk with students about the fun event. Auditions (rehearsal) will be on January 10 and the final event is January 19th. Still lots of open spots needed for volunteers:
  - Looking for a photographer to take pictures during the event. IT was suggested to talk with the high school photography program to see if there are any students able to help.
  - Set-up crew is needed for the day of the event, so we are looking for volunteers to set-up on 1/19.

If we over communicate then we do struggle with space. The gym is not an option for child care as the Y Care uses it. Will research more for next conferences.
