Regular Business:

- Call to Order- Our meeting was called to order at 9:01.
- Approval of Minutes – Kristen Mueller, October minutes approved as written.
- Principal’s Report – Steven Cotton - A student drop off zone reminder was sent in eNews. Please remember to utilize the entire length of the sidewalk along the drop off line when cars are stopped. Children need to use the passenger side to exit the vehicle. Parents need to stay in the vehicle. If you need to get out of your car or use the driver’s side, please park and walk your child to the door. There is no need to wait to be right in front of the stairs/blacktop play area. - Treasurer’s Report – Lisa Goodin - September and October treasurer’s reports are included with this meeting’s handouts. Mornings with Moms raised \$2,525.71 for the 6th grade fund. Fall Fest raised about \$19,000. Funds will be used to pay for Visiting Artist/Visiting Author, Staff Yearbooks, Birthday Book club and classroom wish lists. Funds remaining will be used for additional staff needs.
- President’s Report – Michelle LeMoine - Superintendent’s meeting construction update- The high school project will be finished before Thanksgiving. The updates at Cody will be done around Christmas time but will not start being used until next school year. Bids will be reviewed and accepted this winter for Forest Grove with a plan of breaking ground in Spring 2019. Brian Strusz will fill retiring Dr. Spelhaug’s position as Superintendent. Brian’s position will not be filled but will be changed to a Director of Secondary Education to mirror the current position of Director of Elementary Education. HR Imaging’s contract for school pictures is up for renewal. Michelle is collecting feedback to share with the district.
- Vice-President’s Report – Karyn Green, Megan Barone, & Amy Featherstone - We have a thank you from the Community Foundation for \$500 for our donation to PV Leadership Scholarship fund for Dr. Spelhaug.

New Business:

- Basement extras follow up - miscellaneous old items in the basement still need a new home or to be disposed of.
- Hoops for Heart - 5th & 6th graders will have their Hoops for Hearts event on November 30th.
- 5th & 6th Grade Book Club - We have about 12 students signed up for book club.

- School Giving Project - in lieu of the pajama drive we will be working on a school giving project. Students will learn more about through character circles. It will support King's Harvest. Volunteers that expressed interest in helping with the pajama drive are invited to help support this endeavor.
- Treasurer- Lisa Goodin has submitted her resignation from the position of Treasurer. If you are interested in filling the position as interim treasurer please reach out to a Board member. At our December meeting we will vote to fill the position.
- Yearbook- To help with picture collection, room parent coordinators will be contacted to help with picture upload into the database. Conversation is supporting getting additional access parents so pictures get uploaded at full resolution.

Old Business:

- Visiting Artist - The fall visit went well. Stories and music were well incorporated.
- Halloween Parade and Party - Thank to those that helped with the parade and classroom parties. A list of some ideas to support the game/craft volunteer is being worked on as it seems to be the slot unfilled for classroom parties.
- Conferences/Babysitters - There were at times very busy and other times only a few children. To make the busy times less overwhelming, we can review the budget to add another childcare worker.
- Book Fair - The fair had \$9,781 in sales. The PTA earns a commission from the sale. If the school opts for Scholastic Dollars, rather than a check, the result is a larger commission from the sale. It has been selected to opt for the scholastic dollars commission. Thank you for all those that helped or purchased at the sale.
- Mornings with Mom - Thank for support. Funds raised will be saved for the 6th grade fund.
- Fall Fest - Thank you! In December, we will approve the wish list items for teachers from the funds raised. In response to any questions or comments regarding Fall Fest, a recommendation for some of the raffle items to include "experiences" rather than items and electronics was shared.
