- Principal's Report Steven Cotton
  - O Thank you for organizing and volunteering for fall fest. It was a lot of fun and a successful evening.
  - O There will be a "Safe and Supportive Schools" meeting on January 26, 2023 for K-12. The purpose is to offer insight and give feedback on safety, mental health, equitability, and action steps. Pleasant View needs a parent representative please see Mr. Cotton if you are interested.
  - O Drop off zone has gotten better. Cones are out in the morning to discourage using the merge lane for drop-off. There have been less tardys.
  - O Conference scheduling will open on the PTCFast website on October 14. All conferences will be in person on November 3 from 3:30-8 PM and also between Nov 1 and Nov 11, based on teacher availability.
  - O The Halloween parade will be October 31 from 2:10-2:30. It will be held on the primary playground if the weather is good, and in the gym if not. All are welcome. At 2:30, students will return to classrooms for the Halloween parties. Two designated parents for each classroom will assist with the parties.

  - O Fall fest raised \$22,500. It was noted that the MC (a parent volunteer) was awesome. Donuts with Grown-ups has collected \$4,500 with the mum bill still outstanding.

- O Book Fair preview dates (only books, no extra items) will be November 1 and 2. A volunteer sign-up will be in enews soon.
