Regular Business:

- Call to Order
- Approval of Minutes – Amy Featherstone
Call to order at 6:33 by Amy Featherstone

- Principal’s Report – Steven Cotton
*FAST testing update
*Conferences information – conferences will be virtual this year, link to sign up will be sent on Friday
*CoGat testing – teachers are administering the screener for CoGat testing. Mrs. VanBlaricome will give the full test to those who qualify based on the screener

- Treasurer’s Report – Kim Millage
*We’ve collected \$400 for staff appreciation and the 6th grade mum’s sales went better than expected. We don’t have a bill from Wallace’s yet to pay for the mums picked up.
- President’s Report – Amy Featherstone
*School pictures are Nov 12 and Nov 13.
*Reflections information has been sent out and as well as a new A/B calendar for Term 2. There will be 24 days for both A and B hybrid students in Term 2.
*The results of the district survey showed that the percentage of online/hybrid learners for Term 2 remained relatively the same. Approx 85% hybrid and 15% online. The elementary grades tend to have the highest number of online students. Changes for Term 2 will include 4 section schools making one grade level teacher an online only teacher and the other three hybrid only teachers. Some Bridgeview and Cody online students will now meet with Pleasant View online teachers.
*Enrollment numbers for PVCSD this year have increased from last year. At the end of September, the district had 5,262 students enrolled. The most growth has been the lower elementary grades.
*Forest Grove is right on track and the district expects to take over the building on May 7. The district has begun ordering desks and equipment for the new school.

- Vice-President's Report – Karyn Green, Megan Barone, & Michelle LeMoine
*Karyn Green shared Reflections information. The forms have been handed out and students should be working on their entries. The artist statement is a very important piece in their entry. There will be some sort of recognition after entries have been judged. Right now the district has Jan 14 as the recognition night ceremony.
